

When Do I Attend between 24 August and 4 September?

All students will return full time from 7 September.

Year 8

Year 8s will have their induction day on Friday 4 September, when they will have the whole school to themselves. They will spend the day with their form teacher, getting to know each other and finding out about the safety arrangements in place as well as our normal routines.

Year 9

Year 9s will have their induction day on Thursday 3 September, when they will find out about all the changes in routines. They will also meet some of their subject teachers and make a start on work in some of their subjects. They will also receive all the information they will need for remote learning for the rest of the week.

Year 10

Year 10 will have their induction day on Wednesday 2 September, when they will find out about all the changes in routines. They will also meet some of their subject teachers and make a start on work in some of their subjects. They will also receive all the information they will need for remote learning for the rest of the week.

Year 11

Year 11 will have their induction day on Tuesday 1 September. Timetables will be sorted out on the basis of the subject choices students have made and their back up choices. Students will also learn about the changes to the school day, and will meet some of their subject teachers. They will make a start on their GCSE work and be given remote work for the rest of the week.

Year 12 will return to school on 24 August:
